COVID-19 Pandemic

Due to the nature of the pandemic, the IFSC Competition will take place under the current Queensland Government Health Restrictions. The Iceworld Figure Skating Club will operate within the Iceworld Olympic Ice Rink, Acacia Ridge's COVID Safe Plan for Events. IFSC has submitted an Event COVID-19 Safe Plan and Event Checklist to the management of the Iceworld Olympic Ice Rinks.

Due to the current health requirements and in order to hold the event in a safe environment for all, spectators will be restricted and the movement in and out of the facility will be according to the Covid-19 Safe Plan. For details please see link on the IFSC Website.

Membership Requirements	At close of entries, competitors must be a full financial member of Ice Skating Queensland and their Figure Skating Club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association). The membership must be valid during the full competition period.
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. Ice Skating Australia & Ice Skating Queensland assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.

Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Basic Novice and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.
Practice Sessions	There are NO Official Practice times in-conjunction with IFSC Club Competition.
Entry Process	Online entry submitted directly to LOC by competitor.
Payment Process	Specified payment option: Online Payment at time of entry
Entry Conditions	For entry to be deemed valid both the online entry form, payment and PPC/s for all IJS- level programs must be submitted prior to the close of entries. If you require assistance with the online entry process, please ensure that you contact the competition convener no later than 5 days prior to the close of entries. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE

Music	<p>Provided at Registration: CD 2 copies of each music programme must be supplied as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ be provided on Compact Disc, with only ONE track per disc must be marked with: competitor's name and division (e.g. Junior Ladies) ○ program description (e.g. "Short Program") ○ running time of the music (not skating time). ○ Music must be supplied at the level to be played. Sound will not be adjusted during the event/s <p><u>NB Music is not accepted electronically and/or by USB</u></p>
Other Music file notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD. Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>Two (2) MUST be submitted on CD as specified by the LOC.</p> <p>All CD's must be collected at the end the day's competition. The LOC hold no responsibility for Music not collected. CD's not collected will be destroyed with 24hours of the competition concluding.</p>
PPC	Online direct to LOC at time of entry.
Schedule	A schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and published on the LOC website www.ifsc.org.au .
Awards/Trophies	Trophies/Medals will be awarded to the first three place getters of each division as soon after the event as possible.
