Divisions	<p><u>Apollo – Singles and Groups (up to 4 skaters),</u> Mens & Ladies can be combine in a divisions below</p> <p>Division A: Aussie Skate (Freeskate 1,2,3,4) Division B: Preliminary Division C: Elementary/Basic Novice Division D: Intermediate Novice/Intermediate Division E: Advanced Novice/Junior/Senior Division F: Adult (All Levels)</p> <p>NB Levels may be grouped depending on the number of entries.</p> <p>With regard to "Groups" of up to 4 performers in an entry where the skaters are of different levels, then the division corresponds to the highest level in the group. (e.g. a group consisting of two skaters in Preliminary and two skaters in Basic Novice, will compete in the Basic Novice division).</p>
Withdrawals	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw. No refund permitted after the draw.</p> <p>Prior to the closing date 10% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund. After close of entries and prior to the draw 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund.</p>

Music Provision and File Naming	<p>Provided at Registration: CD 2 copies of each music programme must be supplied as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ be provided on Compact Disc, with only ONE track per disc must be marked with: competitor's name and division (e.g. Junior Ladies) ○ program description (e.g. "Free Program") ○ running time of the music (not skating time). <p>Music must be supplied at the level to be played. Sound will not be adjusted during the event/s. (Music can not be supplied electronically)</p>
Other Music file notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. Two (2) MUST be submitted on CD as specified by the LOC.</p> <p>All CD's must be collected at the end the day's competition. The LOC hold no responsibility for Music not collected. CD's not collected will be destroyed with 24hours of the competition concluding.</p>
