<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test at close of entries are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate™ level.</p>
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	There is NO official practice in-conjunction with this competition.

<b>Music Provision and File Naming</b>	<p><b>Provided at Registration: CD</b>  <b>2 copies of each music programme must be supplied as follows:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ be provided on Compact Disc, with only ONE track per disc must be marked with: competitor's name and division (e.g. Junior Ladies)</li> <li>○ program description (e.g. "Free Program")</li> <li>○ running time of the music (not skating time).</li> <li>○ Music must be supplied at the level to be played. <b>Other Music file notes</b>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD</p> <p><b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b></p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. Two (2) MUST be submitted on CD as specified by the LOC.</p> <p>All CD's must be collected at the end the day's competition. The LOC hold no responsibility for Music not collected. CD's not collected will be destroyed with 24hours of the competition concluding.</p>
<b>PPC</b>	Online direct to LOC at time of entry. Entries close 4 <sup>th</sup> April 2019
