

The IFSC run an Eligibility Points system each for members to receive club benefits.

It is the responsibility of Members to keep their ONLINE Eligibility Points up to date each year.

To update your eligibility points at any time visit www.ifsc.org.au

Points are NOT transferable between members.

Eligibility points are required for members to be considered for benefits as follows:

- Participation in special events and exhibition skates
- Member subsidies/funding
- IFSC State team jackets for similar (as determined each year)
- Club dinner ticket
- Club funded training opportunities

Membership & Eligibility Points

The membership year runs from: 1st April to 31st March each year.

To complete your **eligibility for the year** for the above benefits each member is required to volunteer to receive points. General each time you volunteer you are eligible for 1 point.

Members can obtain volunteer points in a variety of ways including but not limited to:

- 1/ Volunteer at IFSC Competitions
- 2/ Volunteer at the IFSC run BBQ events both at the rink and Bunnings or other external events
- 3/ Assist with IFSC fundraising activities at Skater School competitions
- 4/ Parents may present additional opportunities for consideration to the committee

NB (Volunteer hours are NOT accumulated at Exhibition events if your skater is participating in the event)
