

**Iceworld Figure Skating Club inc. (Acacia Ridge) Terms and Conditions,
Revised January 2016**

1. The club relies on parent volunteers to meet its staffing needs. Therefore, all club member families are strongly encouraged to volunteer service for the club each year. You may be asked to join a sub-committee for organising competitions, fundraising etc. and/or be asked to volunteer at club events and activities.
2. All items associated with operating the club (such as but not limited to printer/copier, office supplies, website, exhibitions, annual awards, additional equipment and incentive payments when competing interstate and internationally) is paid for by Club Fundraising activities.

General Club Volunteer requirements:

3. The minimum volunteer requirement for **each skater 10 years and older is 2 hrs** of service to the club during each of its annual competitions or fundraisers.
4. The minimum volunteer requirement for **each parent of an IFSC Junior Member is 4 hours** of service to the club during each of its annual events.
5. Additional hours of volunteering and/or additional criteria s required for members to receive subsidies benefits and opportunities made possible by the club. Please refer to the club eligibility card.

Volunteer and Participation requirements:

6. The IFSC club has introduced an eligibility card which must be complete by each skating member. Please refer to the card for criteria and benefits. It is the responsibility of each skater/member to keep their card/s up to date. Members must list IFSC as their "Home" club to be eligible for any and all benefits.
7. All members must keep their membership dues current. Skaters must be current financial members to participate in any competition and/or test sessions. In addition, competition fees, test fees, ice fees, and any other monies paid or payable for skating costs to IFSC must be paid up to date.

Senior and Ordinary Members - Shall be at least 18 years of age. They shall have the right to vote, hold office and enjoy all privileges and activities of the IFSC.

Junior and Sub-Junior Members - Shall be under the age of 18. They shall enjoy all privileges and activities of the IFSC.

All members will receive the following benefits:

1Year Membership – April 1 to March 31

Opportunity to participate in all club competitions and tests.

Opportunity to participate in exhibitions, events etc. and benefit from subsidies/grants and development programs sponsored by the club – subject to eligibility cards and additional criteria being met.

I hereby agree to abide by the **Club Code of Ethics and Behaviour** and **Rules of Skating Etiquette**. These can be found at the IFSC website.
