Membership Requirements	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate.</p>
Insurance/Liability	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA & Ice Skating Queensland assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA & Ice Skating Queensland assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
Eligibility to Compete	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA Test level at the close of entries</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Aussie Skaters refer: ISA Communication 101 & ISA Communication 126</p>

Conditions for Online Entry	<p>All entries must be completed online prior to the closing date. Please visit www.ifsc.org.au to complete your entry.</p> <p>All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant state association of their entry submission prior to entering.</p> <p>All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the state association and an affiliated club.</p>
Payment Process	<p>Specified payment option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Online Payment at time of entry
Entry Conditions	<p>Entries will not be considered completed unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Full Payment at the time of entry <p>Late entries will not be accepted after the closing date (15th June 2023)</p>
Divisions	<p><u>Apollo – Singles and Groups (up to 4 skaters)</u></p> <p><u>Mens & Ladies can be combined in divisions below</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aussie Skate – Freeskate 1 to Freeskate 4• Preliminary• Elementary• Basic Novice• Intermediate Novice• Advanced Novice• Junior• Senior• Adult – Bronze, Silver & Gold• Adult – Masters & Masters Elite <p>NB - Levels may be grouped depending on the number of entries.</p> <p>With regard to "Groups", up to 4 performers per entry. Where the skaters are of different levels, then the division corresponds to the highest level in the group. (e.g. a group consisting of two skaters in Preliminary and two skaters in Basic Novice, will compete in the Basic Novice division).</p>
Withdrawals	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided <u>before the draw</u>.</p> <p>No refund permitted after the draw.</p> <p>Prior to the closing date 10% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund. After close of entries and prior to the draw 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund.</p>

Other Music file notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on a USB and must be labelled with name and division:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - USB Strictly 1 track per USB and MUST NOT be recorded with auto play/start <p>Music on mobile phones will NOT be accepted</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, Rhythm dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re- used.</p>
