<p>Technical Requirements</p>	<p>As per current ISU and ISA Technical requirements refer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules • ISU Communications • ISA Regulations and Communications • Aussie Skate™ - refer ISA Communication101 and 126
<p>Results</p>	<p>The ISU’s International Judging System (IJS) will be used for all Divisions Preliminary and above and will be open marking.</p> <p>Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.</p> <p>Aussie Skate™ will be marked by judges only and will be closed marking. No marks will be available.</p>
<p>Event Officials</p>	<p>Judge/s, Technical Controllers and/or Technical Specialists, Data Operators, Video Replay Operators and Accountants for any scheduled events are by invitation.</p>
<p>Membership Requirements</p>	<p>At close of entries, all competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Entries must include valid Club and State Membership numbers and POA’s number (proof of age).</p> <p>Aussie Skate™ entrants must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™; • or if in private lessons only (not in the Aussie Skate program), must be a member of ISQ and an affiliated Club. <p><i>Failure to comply with the membership requirements will result in withdrawal from the event.</i></p>

<p>Insurance/Liability</p>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. <p>Eligibility to Compete</p>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries and must be a current financial member, in good standing with a Figures Skating Club and their State Association.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p>
<p>Practice Sessions</p>	<p>There will be NO Official Practice in-conjunction with this competition.</p>

<p>Conditions of Online Entry</p>	<p>All entries will be submitted on-line with payment. Late entries will not be accepted after the closing date.</p>
<p>Entry Process</p>	<p>Enter on-line via the entry link found on the www.ifsc.org.au or the Sportity App. PPC and music submission must be submitted with the entry.</p> <p>The Competition Convenor will provide a list of competitors as soon as possible after the skaters' eligibility to compete as well as membership status of club, state and national Aussie Skate™ program.</p> <p>A List of Entries will be published as soon as practical and will also be available on the IFSC website and the Event app.</p>

Entry Conditions	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full Payment paid at time of entry • Music File - submitted to be received on entry • Planned Program Content (PPC) for all IJS-level programs received on entry <p>If you require assistance with the online entry process, please ensure that you contact the Competition Convenor via email at competitions@ifsc.org.au, no later than 5 days prior to the close of entries.</p> <p>Note: Late entries will not be accepted after the closing date – 12th June, 2024.</p>
Withdrawal Policy	<p>Prior to closing date: 10% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund.</p> <p>After close of entries and prior to the draw: A medical certificate is required and to be provided before the draw. 50% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund.</p> <p>After the Draw: No refund will be provided.</p>

<p>Other Music file notes</p>	<p>Competitors must provide a backup copy of their competition music upon registration for the event:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • USB only, strictly 1 track per USB - MUST NOT be recorded with auto start/play • Music on mobile phones WILL NOT be accepted. <p>Backup music must be held by the Coach during competition. Backup music WILL NOT be collected at Registration.</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
<p>PPC</p>	<p>Artistic and Aussie Skate Levels do not need to complete the PPC.</p> <p>Planned Program Content (PPC) forms for IJS divisions must be completed online via the online entry form.</p>
<p>Schedule of Events</p>	<p>A schedule will be provided as soon as practical after the close of entries and will be published on the Iceworld Figure Skating website www.ifsc.org.au and via the event app, Sportity.</p> <p>The Schedule will be published subject to change based on entry numbers, including changes to event days.</p>
<p>Awards/Trophies</p>	<p>Event Trophies</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to the first three placegetters of each division.</p> <p>The Crossland Rosebowl is awarded by the Judges for an outstanding performance by a skater Preliminary to Basic Novice.</p>

A booking link will be provided at a later date, available on the IFSC Website and the Event App.</p> <p>Private photographers, please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photography and vidoing is not allowed during the official practice sessions. • No flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups, or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters. • All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event. <p>Please note, no privately engaged photographer or private commercial cameras are allowed where the club has engaged an official photographer.</p>	<p>VIDEOGRAPHY Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras, Tablets, phones or other electronic devices will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.
